Policy Title: Vendor Interaction		
ACGME Institutional Requirement: IV.L.		Page 1 of 1

I. Purpose

To address interactions between vendor representatives/corporations and residents/fellows and each of its ACGME-accredited programs.

II. Policy

A. Residents, Fellows, and Program Directors are prohibited from the following activities:

1. Using their position or knowledge for gain that could conflict with LECOM interests.
2. Accepting any individual gifts, tips or favors from patients, patient’s families, or vendors and others that may influence the decision making that could affect LECOM.
3. Disclosing any information relating to LECOM for personal profit, e.g., giving information to a vendor or business to give them an advantage over their competition.
4. Performing work or accepting employment with others that conflicts with their residency work schedule or compromises LECOM. A conflict may exist if any outside activity hinders or distracts a Residents, Fellows, Program Directors from their job.
